  - c. the pause between each cast must vary based on the amount of line beyond the rod tip
  - d. power must be applied at the proper place at the proper time
  - e. slack must be kept to a minimum
  - f. the stop must be certain and emphatic
- 3. casting stroke and the 'stop'
- 4. loop formation
- 5. shooting line
- 6. aerial mends like a reach mend
- 7. how to analyze your cast and make adjustments to correct common problems
- 8 practice drills that will help you build your casting skills in a step-by-step manner
